

Lavender Stream Sweet Alyssum



- **Floriferous, ball-shaped plant structure**
- **A wonderful scent of honey**
- **Flowers from early spring through autumn**
- **Ideal as a filler in mixed containers, hanging basket or windows boxes**

Lobularia 'Lavender Stream'

- **Use:** Heat tolerant, with sweetly scented blooms that last all summer and into fall. Fast-growing mounds of lavender mist overspill the edges of garden beds and containers. Creates a great hanging basket or window box and is a perfect filler in combinations. Abundant, highly fragrant small blooms all season long; vigorous plant that thrives in hot or cold. Grows best in borders and small groups. Nice trailing out of pots and window boxes. We love the way it looks with geraniums and dracaena spikes in a pot.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. A "heavy drinker" and will prefer evenly moist soil. It will be quick to show drought stress, but should bounce back quickly once rehydrated. In a hanging basket you should be prepared to water often, maybe more than once a day during warm weather. Plants are easier to keep moist when planted in large planters.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-12" tall and 12-15" wide in one season.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Tender Perennial
- **Foliage:** Small leaves. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Small fragrant, lavender blossoms. Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October!
