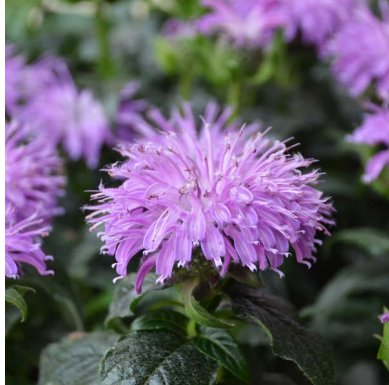


Sugar Buzz Blue Moon Bee Balm



Monarda is native to eastern North America, so it is easy to grow and it multiplies quickly. The flowers' sweet nectar attracts scores of hummingbirds, butterflies, and bees to

the garden. The aromatic foliage smells like mint when crushed and is often used to flavor teas.

- **Use:** This brand new series of SUGAR BUZZ® Monardas is perfectly suited to the middle of the flower border. The unique colors in this series are similar in size, bloom time, and vigor, making it easy for growers to offer the whole lot. Create an eye-catching display of color in sunny borders with mass plantings, or use in combined plantings for containers and perennial beds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** They prefer full all day sun, but will tolerate just afternoon sun. Performs best with consistently moist, but not soggy, soil.
- **Growth:** Compact growth to 20" tall and 18-22' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green foliage forms an upright clump that will fill out containers nicely but won't run all over the garden. It displays above average resistance to powdery mildew.
- **Flower:** Lavender blue flowers are held by attractive purple bracts. A breakthrough, shorter height for this color.
