

# Grand Nain Banana



## *Musa 'Grand Nain'*

- **Use:** Impress the neighbors with this super fast growing banana! In no time you will have a huge, lush tropical paradise with a stand of these! 'Gran Nain' is an outstanding banana variety growing from 6 to 8 feet tall and solid green in color. Very attractive for its landscaping potential and good wind resistance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Always hungry this plant loves lots of water and fertilizer!
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 7-12' tall and 4' wide
- **Hardiness:** 8-10, perennial Mulch around the base of the plant 1– 2 ft in the fall. Plants will need to be wrapped if we get an early frost and fruit have not yet ripened.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large fragrant leaves can be used for cooking.
- **Flower:** In order to produce bananas plants will have to be protected from fall frosts. Produces very large heads of delicious fruit. Bunches may weight up to 150 Lbs. This is a commercial variety that you buy in the grocery store known as 'Chiquita'. The purchased ones are good but if you grow this one yourself you'll see how wonderful these can taste. The full sized fruit ripen rapidly.
