

Poquito Banana



Not too big and not too small- it's just the right size for a container or as a border plant in the garden.

- **Use:** “Just right” ‘Poquito’ quickly grows to about 3 feet high, working well in containers, as a border or in a tropical garden. New growth boasts red spots against green leaves. It’s a perfect thriller plant for containers or any area of the landscape that is wet, such as a rain garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Always hungry this plant loves lots of water and fertilizer!
- **Growth:** This banana can grow 3’ feet tall with an equal spread. Great for the garden as well as containers.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-12, Annual; Some people report them coming back with a good mulching and protection or bringing them inside in the winter and enjoy as a houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The green leaves have red splotches on the new growth.
- **Flower:** It has small, fragrant flowers. Not a fruiting type.
