Nepeta racemosa 'Blue Wonder'

- **Use:** A fragrant, low, soft green/grey silvery foliated selection that forms a spreading mound that will be smothered with larger than usual lavender-blue blossoms in summer, from May to July. Shearing off the spent flowers will promote rebloom on this tough, tolerant, deer resistant, drought resistant selection. Its shorter stature makes it suitable for the front of the border, for use as a groundcover and makes it perfect for underplanting large shrubs. 'Blue Wonder' is a great plant that you'll love almost as much as your cats, that crave its scented foliage, and your local moths and butterflies that flock to it for its nectar.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Spanning 1' & reaching an only slightly taller 2' with blooms.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Aromatic grey foliage beloved by felines.
- **Flower:** Large, deep blue flowers bloom non-stop spring-fall. A rough shearing (cut stems back by about 2/3) after bloom keeps the plants' habit neat and will encourage some repeat bloom until frost.
