

Picture Purrfect Catmint



Nepeta 'Picture Purrfect' PP34502

- **Use:** A new must-have for landscapers! 'Picture Purrfect' has a similar compact height to 'Kitten Around' but has a much broader habit and blooms about two weeks earlier, depending on temperature. Compared to the *Nepeta faassenii* varieties, the blue purple flowers are noticeably larger and a bluer toner than average. A perfect choice for the front of the border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Naturally rounded clumps growing 10-12 inches high and spreads 22-24 inches across at maturity.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The gray-green foliage is strongly scented, so be sure to plant it where you can brush against it. When *Nepeta*'s stems are broken, they release an aroma into the air that tends to attract cats, thus its common name, Catmint.
- **Flower:** Bursts with bigger blooms earlier spring and continues until fall. The vibrant color is a magnet for pollinators.
