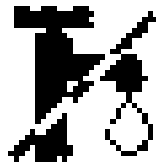


Purple Prelude™ Catmint



Nepeta subsessilis 'Prelude Purple' PP

- **Use:** A stunning new cultivar with very prominent blooms that are almost iris-like. Perfect for the landscape with its large, attractive flowers & appealing color. Good cut flower, border, rock garden, low hedge & edging plant. Aromatic leaves. Attracts cats, bees, butterflies & hummingbirds. Drought tolerant. Deer & gopher resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Spanning 28-36" tall and 24-30" wide in the 2nd year responds well to being cut back. Trim to the ground each fall after frost for best shape.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Aromatic minty foliage beloved by felines.
- **Flower:** Large, bold purple flowers bloom non-stop spring-fall. A rough shearing (cut stems back by about 2/3) after bloom keeps the plants' habit neat and will encourage some repeat bloom until frost if plants look shaggy.
