- <u>Use:</u> An extremely robust cultivar with extra-large flower clusters. The 1-2 -inch-wide plumes are larger than most Nepeta, formed by a collection of soft pink flowers that open in mid-spring. The mounds of foliage give off a wonderful minty fragrance, making them a deer-resistant delight along walkways, or stone walls where they can drape over the edge. Good cut flower, border, rock garden, low hedge & edging plant. Aromatic leaves. Attracts cats, bees, butterflies & hummingbirds. Drought tolerant. Deer & gopher resistant.
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- <u>Growth</u>: Spanning 24-28" tall and 18-22" wide in the 2nd year responds well to being cut back. Trim to the ground each fall after frost for best shape.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-9; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Aromatic minty foliage beloved by felines.
- <u>Flower</u>: Large, pink flowers bloom non-stop spring-fall. A rough shearing (cut stems back by about 2/3) after bloom keeps the plants' habit neat and will encourage some repeat bloom until frost if plants look shaggy. Blooms spring to fall.
