

Neptune Catmint



Your cats will love it! This beautiful catmint flowers for months in the Spring and Summer. Attracts pollinators with its fragrant leaves.

Nepeta kubanica 'Neptune'

- **Use:** This fantastic new dwarf catmint packs a punch with big, violet-blue flowers and big, fresh green leaves on a diminutive form. Quickly reblooms late summer into fall if deadheaded promptly. Dense, upright and never floppy like many other catmints, perfect for a perennial border, wildlife garden or mixed container. Attracts cats, bees, butterflies & hummingbirds. Drought tolerant. Deer & gopher resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 8 to 12 in. tall, 8 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Aromatic minty foliage beloved by felines.
- **Flower:** Nonstop flowers spring to fall. The blue-mauve florets deserve a closer look too, their delicate veining is such a joy! Cut a few stems for indoors in a vase too.
