

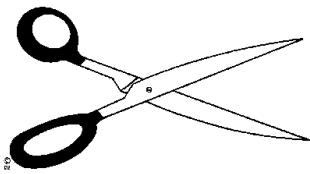
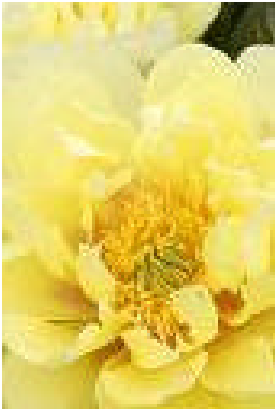
Yellow Bartzella Peony

Paeonia 'Bartzella'

- **Use:** 'Bartzella' is a very rare plant, a hybrid of a herbaceous and a Tree Peony. While it more closely resembles a Tree Peony in growth habit and flower form, its culture is the same as any herbaceous peony, except that it will tolerate partial shade as well as full sun.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full or part sun (afternoon shade is recommended in the South. Prefers well-drained soil enriched with organic matter. If your soil is extremely acid, add a few handfuls of lime at planting time.
- **Growth:** Plants are very big; they can ultimately reach 4' with a similar spread after 5 yrs, although more likely to be 2-3' in height and spread. Plants can take 3-5 years to reach full maturity.
- **Hardiness:** 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flowers:** Flowers of deep sulphur yellow with red flames at the center; some blooms can be 9" across.
- **Tips:** Plant them shallow, mulch in the summer, take off the mulch in the winter, and they prefer a little afternoon shade. Cold winters will ensure lots of blossoms so plant them where they will get cold in the winter. It usually takes a few years for Peonies to produce a lot of flowers!
