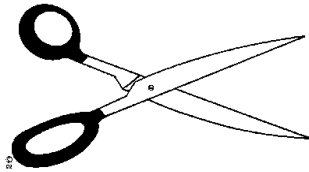


# Coral Sunset Peony Rootstock

## *Paeonia* 'Coral Sunset'

- **Use:** Peonies are classic garden plants that add a bit of nostalgia and charm to the garden. Their fragrant blooms and lush foliage have made them popular for years, and with the recent resurgence in breeding, they will continue to improve. Peonies are simple to grow and can be utilized in many ways, including mass plantings, specimens, or hedges. **WE LOVE PEONIES, BUT THEY ARE NOT A BEGINNER PLANT! LOTS OF RESEARCH NEEDED AND SOIL PREP FOR SUCCESS! ASK FOR A HANDOUT.**
- **Exposure/Soil:** Morning sun and a little afternoon shade preferred (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year in spring and fall. Once established needs only occasional water. In very hot summers it may go summer dormant. SOIL is very important and must be well drained and have a pH of 6.5-7 so Georgia clay will need to be amended with Lime.
- **Growth:** Grows 28 inches tall and 24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green lobed leaves.
- **Flowers:** A favorite of the breeder, this outstanding peony produces intense sunset coral, semi-double blossoms with rose overtones and a fluffy boss of deep yellow stamens in the center. The lightly fragrant flowers are long lasting in fresh bouquets. 'Coral Sunset' blooms early in the peony season. It is highly prized for its exemplary plant habit.
- **Tips:** Plant them shallow, mulch in the summer, take off the mulch in the winter, and they prefer a little afternoon shade. Cold winters will ensure lots of blossoms so plant them where they will get cold in the winter.
