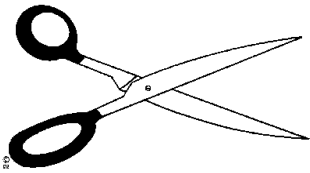


Peony Karl Rosenfeld



Huge fragrant blooms great for cutting!

Paeonia 'Karl Rosenfeld'

- **Use:** Carefree, long-lived plant rarely requires division. Elegant flowers are gorgeous in bouquets.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–light shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Grows 24 to 30 inches tall.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flowers:** Blooms up to 8” across! This is really one of the most prized of all peony varieties, notable both for its bloom size and the intensity of its color. Deep crimson fully double blooms in May through June.
- **Tips:** Plant them shallow, mulch in the summer, take off the mulch in the winter, and they prefer a little afternoon shade. Cold winters will ensure lots of blossoms so plant them where they will get cold in the winter. Add a little lime to the soil.
