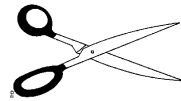


# Lovely Rose Peony

## *Paeonia 'Lovely Rose'*

- **Use:** A stunning herbaceous perennial with large, fragrant double flowers that are bright pink. The fluffy flowers are surrounded by lush, light green foliage that creates a lovely backdrop for the blooms. Award of Landscape Merit 2009.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–light shade shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Grows 28 to 32 inches tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lush foliage compliment the flowers. May go summer dormant.
- **Flowers:** Carmine-rose pink, semi-double, early, 32" tall, hybrid. A bright, warm pink flower with lovely large upright petals that exude elegance. Extremely strong stems on a shorter plant that will attract attention in the flower bed.
- **Tips:** Plant them shallow, mulch in the summer, take off the mulch in the winter, and they prefer a little afternoon shade. Cold winters will ensure lots of blossoms so plant them where they will get cold in the winter.
