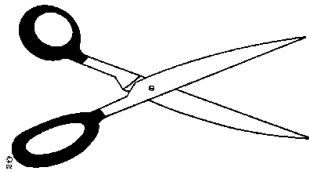

Paeonia 'Myrtle Gentry'

- **Use:** Peony Myrtle Gentry is a double rosy white, late-midseason, very fragrant, strong stems. Often called the most fragrant peony of all, Carefree, long-lived plant rarely requires division. Elegant, flowers are gorgeous in bouquets.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–light shade shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year in spring and fall. Once established needs only occasional water. In very hot summers it may go summer dormant.
- **Growth:** Grows 30-36 inches tall.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green lobed leaves.
- **Flowers:** Very delightful tea rose fragrance. Perfect rose form opens pale pink with hints of cream and apricot before maturing to a lovely white.
- **Tips:** Plant them shallow, mulch in the summer, take off the mulch in the winter, and they prefer a little afternoon shade. Cold winters will ensure lots of blossoms so plant them where they will get cold in the winter.
