Penstemon 'Cha Cha Series'

- **Use:** The vibrant, tubular flowers of this easy perennial are sure to be the brightest spot in the garden and a magnet for hummingbirds and butterflies. Dark green leaves cloak its upright, bushy form, with blooms starting in late spring to early summer, continuing into fall in many climates. Perfect for borders and mixed containers, and a cutting garden essential!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Reaches 24-28" tall and 22" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Thin, dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Dark cherry-red, purple, or pink tubular flowers and a upright, bushy habit. It is very free-flowering and blooms from spring to late fall. The lovely dark seed heads are great for arrangements.

Mixed beds, sun garden, cottage garden, bank. Lovely as a cut flower and long blooming too.
