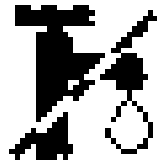


Flock of Flamingos Bearded Tongue



Penstemon 'Flock of Flamingos' PP35502

- **Use:** Large, clump forming Penstemon with attractive Shrimp pink flowers that shift to baby pink as they age. Very long bloom period and masses of flowers. Flowers are quite large and are very attractive to Bumble bees. A flock of Flamingos is called a Flamboyance. Very aptly named. A prolific flowering variety that will provide long-lasting color for perennial beds and borders, rock gardens, and patio containers. Great for cut flower displays. Attractive blooms make nice sweeping drifts when planted in mass. US native.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established. This is a vigorous grower that performs best in moderately fertile/well-drained, but tolerates poor soils.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 15 to 20 in. tall, 16 to 18 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Its glossy narrow leaves remain green in color throughout the season.
- **Flower:** Impressive spikes of shrimp pink flowers that age to shell pink for a stunning multi-hued effect from spring until fall. Trim old flowers for a tidy plant and best reblooming.
