Penstemon 'TNPENHPU' PPAF

- <u>Use</u>: Long-blooming, showy, abundant spikes of flowers that are a valuable source of nectar for bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. The vigorous, bushy, compact habit makes this a great plant for perennial borders, rock gardens, and containers. Blooms are a lovely addition to cut flower arrangements. Attractive blooms make nice sweeping drifts when planted in mass.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established. This is a vigorous grower that performs best in moderately fertile/well-drained, but tolerates poor soils.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 15 to 24 in. tall, 16 to 18 in. wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9 Perennial
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Leathery, glossy narrow leaves remain green in color throughout the season.
- **Flower:** Impressive spikes of voluptuous purple flowers from spring until fall. Trim old flowers for a tidy plant and best reblooming.
