

Bearded Tounge/ Penstemon



Penstemon digitalis 'Mystica'

- **Use:** Deep red foliage with white/pale pink blooms! Gorgeous accent foliage all season long! 1996 PPA Perennial Plant of the Year, and well-deserved! Hummingbirds and butterflies love this perennial, not to mention being deer resistant. An improvement over 'Husker's Red'
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly to 30" tall and plant them 20-36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage that emerges green, changes to dark maroon-red during the summer, and finally changes again to blazing red in the fall.
- **Flower:** Pale pink/ white blooms May-October. Deadhead promptly for continual bloom.
