Bearded Tounge/ Penstemon

- <u>Use</u>: Deep red foliage with white/pale pink blooms! Gorgeous accent foliage all season long! 1996 PPA Perennial Plant of the Year, and well-deserved! Hummingbirds and butterflies love this perennial, not to mention being deer resistant. An improvement over 'Husker's Red'
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly to 30" tall and plant them 20-36" apart.
- *Hardiness*: 5-10 Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Foliage that emerges green, changes to dark maroon-red during the summer, and finally changes again to blazing red in the fall.
- Flower: Pale pink/ white blooms May-October. Deadhead promptly for continual bloom.
