best flowering performance and to help avoid powdery mildew concerns. A favorite of pollinators.

## Phlox 'Cloudburst'

- <u>Use:</u> 'Cloudburst' has dark purple buds open to lavender purple flowers with bright pink eyes that cover a broad, mounding, billowy habit. The pleasantly fragrant flowers cover the plant nearly all the way to the ground starting early summer and continue to bloom all summer long. Frustrated with mildew on your Tall Garden Phlox? 'Cloudburst' has excellent disease resistance; with broad, glossy, dark green leaves staying clean all summer long.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Does not like sprinklers, water soil not leaves.
- **Growth:** Fast growth of 28" x 42" wide
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-9; Perennial.
- Foliage: Deciduous; Light green mildew resistant foliage.
- Flower: Lavender purple flowers have bright pink eyes. Fragrant. Long blooming. Great cut flower.
