## Ultra Pink Garden Phlox









These perennials are a favorite of gardeners around the world and a staple of North American native gardens. Be sure to locate these plants in full sun for the best flowering performance and to help avoid powdery mildew concerns. A favorite of pollinators.

## Phlox hybrid 'Opening Act Ultra Pink' PP32093

- <u>Use:</u> This early blooming fragrant Phlox will add a long season of color to your garden with its fluorescent rose pink flowers. Overall, it looks light pink. The dark green, glossy foliage is mildew and disease resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Does not like sprinklers, water soil not leaves.
- **Growth:** Fast growth of 22-28" x 32-36" wide. Spreads slowly by stolons. Forms a dome-like habit
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4a-8b; Perennial.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous; The dark green, glossy foliage is mildew and disease resistant. We recommend planting your phlox in an area with good airflow.
- <u>Flower:</u> This Phlox isn't just pink, it's ULTRApink! With this addition to the Opening Act Phlox Collection, it is officially the brightest, most vibrant color of the set. In spring-early summer, this plant produces fluorescent rose pink flowers that are slam-on-your-breaks intense. If sheered back, these plants will rebloom later in the season.
