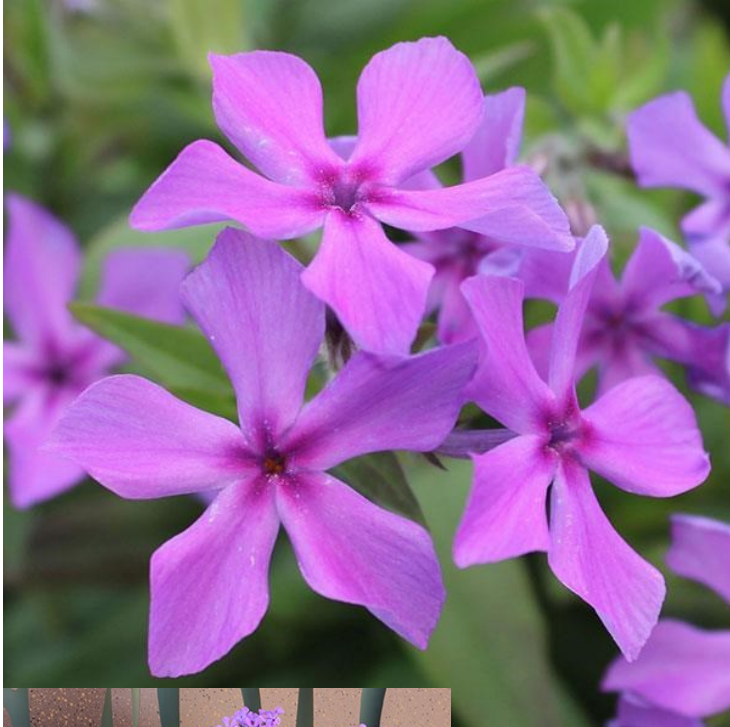


Paparazzi Jagger Woodland Phlox



Excellent for shade gardens. Early flowering and great heat and humidity tolerance for durability in pots and in the landscape! Great choice as a ground-cover or accent planting.



Phlox 'Paparazzi Jagger'

- **Use:** Feature fragrant, bright pink-purple and short, bushy, reddish stems with dark green foliage. Plants are noted for having vigorous growth, early flowering, a long flowering period and good resistance to powdery mildew. Once Levine is established it will be very drought tolerant. Phlox plants attracts hummingbirds, butterflies and bees. A long-lived, carefree native groundcover
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial shade is best. Prefers moist, well drained soil, but is fairly drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-12" tall and wide. Plants will spread and can form large colonies over time.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-11; Will need protection from cold winds in our area.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Foliage is lance shaped and medium green.
- **Flowers:** Blooms of vibrant purple with a darker eye. Early flowering with excellent heat and humidity tolerance. Fragrant and colorful too. Sterile so they will continue to bloom!
