

# Blue Ribbons Woodland Phlox



## *Phlox divaricata* 'Blue Ribbons' PP34,928

- **Use:** Beautifully variegated foliage sets 'Blue Ribbons' apart from the rest! It is a fragrant, slowly spreading ground cover for shade that sports pastel lavender-blue blooms in early spring. Ideal for use as a gently spreading groundcover for shade that provides a long season of interest, 'Blue Ribbons' is also a fantastic filler for containers and small spaces with dappled shade.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial shade is best. Prefers moist, well drained soil, but is fairly drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows up to about 10" tall and 20" inch wide and can be pruned after flowering.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-10; Perennial; Will need protection from cold winds in our area.
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen variegated foliage edged with cream-colored borders, and in the cooler seasons, the leaves take on a lovely red hue.
- **Flowers:** Fragrant, light lavender flower clusters in spring, giving bees and butterflies an important source of early-season nourishment.



Blue Ribbons is very good heat- and humidity resistant and very winter hardy. You will definitely enjoy this outstanding perennial!
