- **Use:** This long-legged beauty stands tall, proudly showing off large panicles of hot coral pink flowers held on dark purple stems. The oldest flowers in the panicles are a beautiful shade of light coral pink. The flowers attract butterflies and are deer resistant. 'Glamour Girl' maintains bright green, healthy looking foliage on strong stems all summer, putting on a flower show in mid through late summer. This variety powers through hot, humid summers with ease and is one of our most powdery mildew resistant cultivars.
- Exposure/Soil: Prefers full sun to part sun. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Does not like sprinklers, water soil not leaves.
- <u>Growth</u>: Fast growth of 32" x 18-24" wide
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 4-9 Perennial.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous; The foliage is dense and compact with deep green, lance-shaped leaves. Extremely mildew resistant bright green foliage remains attractive all season.
- *Flower:* Large panicles of hot coral pink flowers bloom on strong dark purple stems. Butterflies and hummingbirds can't seem to resist this glamorous beauty either.
