

Early Spring Lavender Creeping Phlox/ Thrift



Phlox subulata 'Early Spring Lavender'

- **Use:** Spring Lavender Moss Phlox is smothered in stunning lavender star-shaped flowers with gold eyes at the ends of the stems in late spring. Its tiny needle-like leaves remain forest green in color throughout the year.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 6 in. tall, 3 ft. wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8, perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Small trailing leaves.
- **Flower:** Produces a showy display of bright, lavender flowers smothering the plant in late spring; prune lightly after flowering to encourage a dense growth habit
