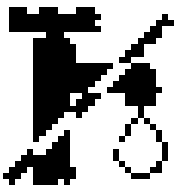


Spring Lavender Creeping Phlox



Phlox subulata 'Spring Lavender'

- **Use:** Plant a carpet of color! Beautiful masses of flowers topping creeping stems make an attractive ground cover or accent in a rock garden. Excellent bank cover. Tolerates some drought.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 6 in. tall, 1 ft. wide. This plant will require occasional maintenance and upkeep, and should only be pruned after flowering to avoid removing any of the current season's flowers.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8, perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Small trailing leaves.
- **Flower:** Lavender blooms are long lasting from spring– summer.



DROUGHT TOLERANT! Carpets hillside in blossoms. Good for erosion control.
