## Phlox subulata 'Spring Lavender'

- <u>Use:</u> Plant a carpet of color! Beautiful masses of flowers topping creeping stems make an attractive ground cover or accent in a rock garden. Excellent bank cover. Tolerates some drought.
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Sun– part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fer-tilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- <u>**Growth</u>**: Moderate grower to 6 in. tall, 1 ft. wide. This plant will require occasional maintenance and upkeep, and should only be pruned after flowering to avoid removing any of the current season's flowers.</u>
- *<u>Hardiness</u>:* Zone 3-8, perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Small trailing leaves.
- <u>Flower</u>: Lavender blooms are long lasting from spring
  summer.
