

Crystal Peak White Obedient Plant



Physotegia virginiana 'Crystal Peak White'

- **Use:** Called obedient plant or false dragonhead, is a rhizomatous perennial that is native to North America from Quebec to Manitoba south to Florida and New Mexico. Emerging from a dormant crown in spring, a cluster of green stems shoots upward to 30", each clothed by 3" long, narrow, waxy, dark green leaves. The sturdy clumps are topped all summer with pure white, snapdragon-like flowers, which can be twisted around the stem and will remain where you put them...hence, the common name!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun, very easy to please. Prefers well-drained soils so please amend red clay. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 14-16" tall or more and 12" wide it remains compact.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; long leaves
- **Flower:** A multitude of white flower spikes throughout the summer.
