Physotegia virginiana 'Pink Manners'

- **Use:** Tubular flowers in shades of lavender-pink adorn this taller sport of 'Miss Manners' from midsummer through autumn. Unlike other so-called obedient plants, *Physotegia* 'Pink Manners' does not run around like other physostegias...or past presidents. Emerging from a dormant crown in spring, a cluster of green stems shoots upward to 30", each clothed by 3" long, narrow, waxy, dark green leaves.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full— part sun, very easy to please. Prefers well-drained soils so please amend red clay. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 36" tall or more and 20" wide. An adaptable and easy-to-grow native, the strong stems do not require staking.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; long leaves
- **Flower:** A multitude of pale pink flower spikes throughout the summer. Can be used as a cut flower.
