## Platycodon 'Astra White'

- <u>Use:</u> Balloon Flowers are summer-blooming cousins to the more familiar Bellflowers. The small habit of this variety makes it a good choice for rock gardens and mixed containers. Division is seldom necessary, and not always very successful because of the carrot-like root. Drought tolerant when established.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth**: Grows 8-10" tall and 6-8" wide. A dwarf form perfect for containers or rock gardens.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-8;Perennial
- Foliage: Evergreen if brought indoors in winter
- <u>Flower</u>: Unique puffy balloon-shaped flower buds open to reveal beautiful white star-shaped blooms. Adored by butterflies, the blooms make superb cut flowers.
