- <u>Use:</u> Balloon Flowers are summer-blooming cousins to the more familiar Bellflowers. This selection forms a compact mound of green foliage, bearing inflated buds that open into star-shaped violet-blue blossoms. The small habit of this variety makes it a good choice for rock gardens and mixed containers. Division is seldom necessary, and not always very successful because of the carrot-like root.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: Reaches 6 in. tall, 10 in. wide; flowers to 8 in. tall.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-9; Perennial
 - Foliage: Evergreen if brought indoors in winter
- **<u>Flower</u>**: This heavy bloomer has very large blue flowers that begin in the shape of a balloon before opening, hence it's name.
