- <u>Use:</u> If you love blue flowers and butterflies, this easy-to-care Blue Plumbago plant is then a must in your garden. It is a vigorous grower and a non-stop bloomer, profusely flowering spectacularly throughout the summer.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial shade. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers. Drought tolerant once established. Flowers dropping may mean to much water. If you are not good at watering we recommend using **Soil Moist**.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and 3' wide. Use in landscape, combinations and planters.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 8-11, Tender Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch 2-3" with pine bark around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Deciduous; Small ear shaped eaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Light blue flowers that are prolific during the warmer months of the year.
