

Mix Double Sweetheart Primrose



A newly developed species with fully double, large flowers in several exciting colors.

Primula acaulis 'Double Sweetheart'

- **Use:** Beloved harbinger of spring that puts forth an abundance of cheery blossoms. Fragrant and can also be used as a houseplant and later planted in the garden to come back again next year! Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Bright indirect light indoors. Part sun-shade outdoors when temps are above 40 degrees. Moist, well-drained soil. Keep water off the leaves and flowers for best results. Must have good drainage and prefer not to be watered from overhead. Beware of slugs and snails.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual/ Sometimes Tender Perennial; Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. May go summer dormant.
- **Flower:** Frilly flowers almost robust in shape, in shades of cream yellow to rose. Enjoy these cherry blossoms from late winter-spring
