

# Supernova Primrose



## *Primula polyanthus* 'Supernova'

- **Use:** Beloved harbinger of spring that puts forth an abundance of cheery blossoms. Fragrant and can also be used as a houseplant and later planted in the garden to come back again next year! A well loved selection of the traditional Polyanthus that announces the arrival of spring year after year. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil. Keep water off the leaves and flowers for best results. Beware of slugs and snails.
- **Growth:** Grows 12" tall and 8" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. May go summer dormant.
- **Flower:** Produces large blooms up to 6.5cm (2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>in) wide in a good variety of colours.
