

Summer Daze Self Heal



Attractive to butterflies. Prunella is a vigorous, hardy perennial that is excellent for the front of borders. It can be used for fine edgings in herb or vegetable gardens.



Prunella 'Summer Daze'

- **Use:** Roll out those lazy, hazy, crazy Daze of summer. Are you singing yet? You will be amazed when you see how many vibrant pink tubular blooms this plant produces. This is an absolutely stunning groundcover useful for covering an embankment. This plant makes an excellent ground cover in the shady corners of the garden. It forms a dense carpet of green foliage and summer flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 18 "tall, by 12-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. The oak-leaved foliage is attractive even when not in bloom.
- **Flower:** These little plants are smothered in pink blooms all summer long! Blooms begin in June and continue all the way through to fall frosts.
