

# Silver Bouquet Lungwort



## *Pulmonaria 'Silver Bouquet'*

- **Use:** This plant has it all – mildew-resistance, heat and humidity tolerance with large coral to pink to violet flowers that “look at you.” It is a great solution when you are looking to add early spring color to your shade garden with deer resistance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (afternoon shade)-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Perform best in compost-enriched soils with regular irrigation. Dry conditions can lead to disease issues and leaf scorch. Clean up in the spring by removing old or damaged foliage from the previous year.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 7-10” tall, spreading 20” wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Silver green foliage molted with bright green. Mildew resistant.
- **Flower:** Short stocks sporting clusters of small flowers that open pink and mature blue blooms from late winter into spring attracting butterflies.

**Deer Resistant and loves the shade! Works well under deciduous trees and along woodland pathways.**
