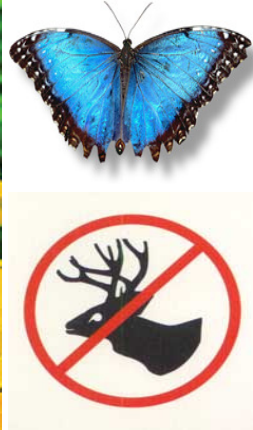


# Indian Summer Rudbeckia

## ***Rudbeckia hirta 'Indian Summer'***

- **Use:** This All-America Selections winner with its huge blossoms and vigorous, uniform plants adds bold, eye-catching color to borders and beds. Looks amazing with grasses.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water once established. Good drainage is a must.
- **Growth:** Grows to a height of 36" and a spread of 12-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 3-8 Reseeds. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Slightly fuzzy leaves are more mildew resistant than other Rudbeckias.
- **Flower:** Produces long, golden-yellow rays surrounding chocolate-black centers from July thru September followed by mahogany foliage in the fall.
