

# Little Gold Star Black eyed Susan



## *Rudbeckia fuldiga sullivatti* 'Little Gold Star'

- **Use:** While 'Goldsturm' can stand waist-high in bloom with tall, wispy flowering stems, 'Little Goldstar' is a much more compact, proportional plant. Standing just knee high, this plant forms a bushy, short clump of rich green foliage covered with a dome of closely spaced, starburst-shaped, 2-2.5", golden yellow blossoms held just above the foliage. Looks great with any type of grass, in borders or mass plantings in sunny gardens. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-16" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 4-10 Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Very well-branched stems carry loads of flowers from mid-summer through early fall. Over 80 flowers have been counted on a single plant!

**Super tough and drought tolerant  
once established.**
