

Rajun Cajun Argentinian Petunia



Ruellia elegans 'Rajin Cajun'

- **Use:** Vivid red flowers and a low growth habit with wispy flower stems. A tough little plant that's easy to grow and holds up well through heat and humidity. These beautiful flowers have 5 petals and they open in the morning hours. Don't let the fragile appearance fool you though, because this is a really tough plant that can withstand high heat and humidity. Attractive to hummingbirds and butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefer full sun but will tolerate some shade (to the sacrifice of some flowering and they will grow taller). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Will reach 12-18" tall with an 18" spread.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-11 Perennial, Mulch in winter for best success.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green foliage.
- **Flower:** Topped from June through frost with terminal clusters of 5-petaled, bright scarlet-red flowers.



Non stop flowers from spring until fall. Needs very little care and is drought tolerant once established. A 4.79 out of 5 from the Athens Select program at UGA.
