

# Scotch Moss



## *Sagina subulata 'Aurea'*

- **Use:** Lush chartreuse moss like foliage 1" tall . Good along walkways, and between stepping stones as it is able to withstand light foot traffic.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers evenly moist, compost-rich soil. Likes a lot of moisture, but not "wet feet". May need to be protected from hot afternoon sun in the south. Best planted in morning sun and afternoon shade.
- **Growth:** Grows 2" tall and will continue to spread.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Chartreuse foliage.
- **Flower:** Tiny translucent white flowers add to its beauty in spring.

**It is fun to create a checkerboard effect with Scotch and Irish Moss.**
