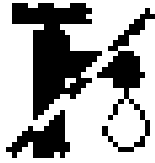


# Hummingbird Falls Sage



## *Salvia x guaranitica* 'Hummingbird Falls'

- **Use:** The World's First Hanging Basket Salvia So excited to see a perennial Salvia in a hanging basket! Quickly grows into a large ball of sapphire blue flowers which attracts loads of hummingbirds. Deer resistant too! Keep in basket or plant in ground..
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 1-2' tall and wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** This compact, freely branching salvia has the nectar-rich deep purple flower wands sought after by hummingbirds, who found this as soon as the first flower bloomed! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October!



Grow your own hummingbird feeder!  
Grow in large baskets or mass along the garden's edge.
