Salvia is a staple item for every sunny garden. It asks little more than sunshine and a little drink every once in a while in return for producing a bountiful mass of colorful flower spires from late spring into early summer. It forms an upright



Salvia 'Indigo Girl'

- **Use:** The darkest color of the COLOR SPIRES® Series, with flowers so rich and vibrant, they glow! Indigo blue flowers are held in dark calyxes and are produced on top of a vigorous, bushy mound of foliage. 'Indigo Girl' is intermediate between *S. nemorosa* and *S. pratensis* and has the best of both worlds: large, brightly colored flowers with the excellent foliar canopy. This fabulous variety matches the bloom times as the rest of the series, so you can display all of the colors at once. This will rebloom later in the season if deadheaded.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** It has a plant height of 20-22" and a spread of 20-22" and stays in excellent compact form.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. With its blue-gray, lance-shaped aromatic foliage, it makes an attractive accent all summer long
- **Flower:** Indigo blue flowers are held in dark calyxes in a nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
