## Salvia Hybrid 'Rhythm and Blues' PP29585

- Use: Ideal for pollinator gardens, this compact plant blooms early and repeat blooms dark blue flowers atop dark green foliage. Quickly grows into a large ball of sapphire blue flowers which attracts loads of hummingbirds. Deer resistant too!
- Exposure/Soil: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- Growth: Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 3' tall and wide in one season. Needs to be cut to the ground after frost ends its six month floral display and the stems are dead.
- Hardiness: Zone 6b-10b; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with beautiful deep blue-purple strength. Exflowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! The flower size, flower count, and compact habit are an improvement over other Salvia guaranitica clones on the market.
