The Salvia is a hummingbird and bee friendly plant, which contributes to an environmentally friendly garden. Salvia Salgoon® is a great garden performer, but suits a big planter as well.

Salvia 'Salgoon Series'

- **Use:** The Salgoon Series are vigorous Salvia plants with many side shoots and with exceptionally long flowering stems. In every variety the stems, foliage and flowers have a beautiful contrasting dark color. Grows uniformly and has a heavy bloom set.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4-6 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Grows 18" tall and spreads to 12" wide. Excellent for edging and ground covers. When plantings space 12-15" apart at least for fast display. Looks best if occasionally cut back.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10, Perennial/Reseeding Annual! Fantastic at coming back year after year we had great success with them in our garden coming back many years! Just be sure not to mulch heavily around plant so seeds can germinate.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Even the leaves add beauty with their finer-textured, dark-green color.
- **Flower:** The nectar rich flowers are a magnet for pollinating insects, making this a useful plant for a wildlife area too. Attracts bees, butterflies and friendly pollinators Loved by hummingbirds.
