

Santa Barbara Sage



Salvia leucanthemum 'Santa Barbara'

- **Use:** This amazing introduction from CA is a breakthrough in the world of salvias. Imagine a wonderful fall-flowering sage that only reaches 2' tall, but with a spread of 3-4' in width, and you have S. 'Santa Barbara'.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 3-4' tall and wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** 7b-10 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with spike of fuzzy, purple flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from May until late October!
