## *Salvia x 'Swiftly Series'*

- **Use:** Densely packed spikes of showy flowers are held well above extra-compact, mounding green foliage. Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Must have good drainage. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows to 12 to 18 inches tall and 12 inches wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9 perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fragrant, green leaves.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with rose, white, or violet flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
