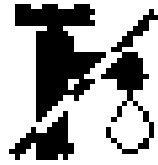


# Mirage Bicolor Rose Autumn Sage



## *Salvia greggii* 'Mirage Bicolor Rose'

- **Use:** Compact and tidy, growing 12 -14 inches tall and a bit wider. The fragrant foliage is topped with a profusion of nectar-rich, two toned flowers of deep rose-pink and creamy-white, summer into fall. The appealing, bold display attracts hummingbirds, butterflies and bees. Plant in full sun to light shade with moderate to occasional water. Makes a good container subject. Deer resistant and attracts hummingbirds in droves.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 2-3' tall and wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 7a-9b Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Use 3-4" around plant in the winter. Plants will not come out of winter dormancy until late May the following year.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Its tiny, smooth, elliptical leaves form a light, airy backdrop for the dramatic flowers. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Large, rose and cream bicolor flowers with a rounded habit. Retains its color in the heat. Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October!

**We love them for their long lasting blooms and strength in the heat and drought.**
