

Apex Blue Salvia



Salvia nemerosa 'Apex Blue'

- **Use:** This especially compact selection is taller than most, for bigger impact. A stunning addition to any border with spikes of blue flowers that top dense, shrub-like clumps of fragrant, green foliage throughout summer. Excellent for adding bold color in mass plantings. Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 18 in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fragrant, green leaves.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with fragrant blue flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
