

April Night Salvia



Salvia nemerosa 'April Night'

- **Use:** This new petite salvia blooms a month earlier than the popular 'May Night', providing an extended bloom period from spring right through summer! Blue-violet flower spikes rise from dense, sturdy, upright foliage. Great drought and mildew resistance. Perfect for meadows, garden borders, and mixed patio containers. . Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 12-24" tall and wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-10; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with beautiful blue flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
