

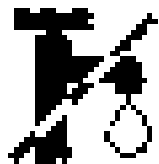
Blue Hill Sage



Salvia nemerosa 'Blue Hill'

- **Use:** With a long blooming season, running spring through autumn, the Blue Hill salvia brings exquisiteness to patio pots and landscapes alike. Vibrant blue flowers are excellent in combination with golden flowered annuals and perennials in the mixed border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Good drainage a must. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** It has a plant height of 10-12" and a spread of 6-8" wide and stays in excellent compact form.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fragrant, green leaves.
- **Flower:** Blooms early on dark, 8-10 in. stems that hold deep ultraviolet blue flower spikes.

Easy to grow and comes back every year. Enjoy 5+ months of flowers.
